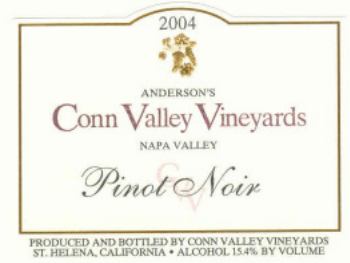

Vintage: 2004

Color: Ruby, purple edges.

Aroma: Tobacco leaf, espresso roast, the complex aromas of chocolate, fruit and oak are balanced and well done.

Taste: Medium bodied, a good balance of Pinot fruit, acid and oak. Some mocha and ripe plums. In the glass this wine opens up with black fruits and cassis. Long finish, sweet aftertaste. Should be at its best in 7-9 years. A great wine to bring in 2012.

The Year: The 2004 growing season was one of the fastest and earliest in history. The quality of fruit was excellent and the yield light. The season started with a warm spring, followed by a mild summer with extreme heat at the end. The flavors for 2004 are high quality and intense and the colors beautiful

Aged: 22 months in French oak 60 gallon cooperage.

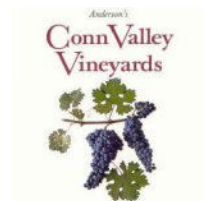

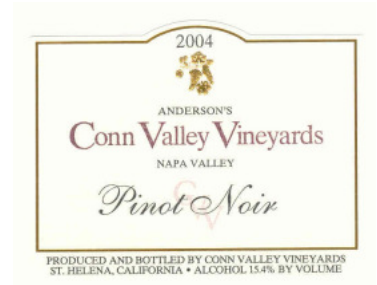
